Grades 1—5 will be required to request a **1st Choice and 2nd Choice** of day/time when registering for classes. **Parents will be notified after the Sep 1st deadline of their child's placement.** All other grades choose one day/time and will NOT be contacted prior to classes starting in October.

Generally speaking, classes are held **weekly beginning October 4th through April 20th** (except Pre-School & Kindergarten which begins October 12th and 9th Grade which is held every other week and begins September 12th) with breaks for holidays and Troy School District closures—see the back page...

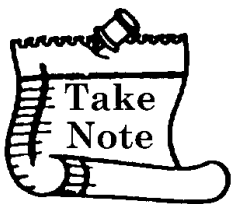

1st	<p>1st Grade is a required PRE-REQUISITE for the 2nd Grade Sacrament of First Eucharist and First Reconciliation. <i>If your 2nd Grade child has not completed a 1st Grade course here or at another parish, he/she will be registered in <u>this class this year</u> and the 2nd Grade program next year as a 3rd grader.</i> Offered weekly on Mondays at 4:30—5:45pm And on Tuesdays at either 4:30—5:45pm OR 6:45—8:00pm</p>	\$90
2nd	<p>2nd Grade prepares for and celebrates the Sacraments of First Eucharist & First Reconciliation. A parent is expected to attend scheduled Parent/Child class sessions with their 2nd Grade child. Every 2nd Grade child must submit a copy of his/her BAPTISM CERTIFICATE at the time of registration. <i>If your 2nd Grader has not completed 1st Grade sessions, please see the 1st Grade description above.</i> Offered weekly on Tuesdays at either 4:30—5:45pm OR 6:45—8:00pm</p>	\$130

4th 5th	<p>4th & 5th Grade <i>If your 4th or 5th Grade child has not prepared for or celebrated his/her First Eucharist, please note that on your registration form. 6th 7th 8th	<p>6th, 7th & 8th Grade - 7th & 8th Grade are required PRE-REQUISITES for the 9th Grade Confirmation Program. <i>If your 7th or 8th Grade child has not previously been enrolled in Religious Education or has not prepared for or celebrated his/her First Eucharist and/or First Reconciliation, please note that on your registration form.</i> Offered weekly on Wednesdays at 4:30—5:45pm OR 6:45—8:00pm</p>	\$95
9th	<p>9th Grade (R.E.A.D.Y.) prepares for and celebrates the Sacrament of Confirmation while encouraging teens to participate in our BASIC Youth Ministry program. <i>If your 9th Grader made his/her First Communion at another parish, submit a copy of his/her BAPTISM CERTIFICATE with registration.</i> 9th Graders will attend a retreat (cost included in registration) in February 2011. Participation in 7th & 8th Grade religion is a required pre-requisite for 9th Grade. 2X monthly on Sundays at 11:30am—12:45pm begins September 12th* see yellow parent letter mailed to each 9th grade home.</p>	\$180

Policies & Procedures:

- ⇒ **ATTENDANCE POLICY**—Please contact your Program Coordinator at 248-689-8380, (Pre-K—3rd grade at Ext. 117; 4th—5th grade at Ext. 103; 6th—8th grade at Ext. 101; and 9th grade at Ext. 106), or your child’s catechist to report an absence. If a student misses more than four class sessions and does not complete the missed work, they will not be considered as having completed that grade. Students are responsible for missed material. ❖
- ⇒ **SACRAMENT POLICY**—The sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Eucharist are celebrated in the 2nd Grade. **Completion of the 1st Grade Program is a pre-requisite** for the 2nd Grade Program. The Confirmation Program is a three year program beginning in 7th grade, with the Rite of Confirmation at the end of 9th grade. **Students are expected to participate in and complete all three preparation years.** Candidates must exhibit knowledge and understanding of the Catholic faith prior to reception of the sacraments. ❖
- ⇒ **CIRCLE OF GRACE**—The Archdiocese of Detroit instituted a program for the safe environment education of young people supported and mandated by the Archbishop of Detroit. This is **Circle of Grace**. It is meant to **be integrated into the current curriculum** for religious education for grades K—8. This will take place in 1 or 2 lesson(s) in all of these grades during the course of this school year. **If you would like to review the lesson plans**, you may do so by stopping by the Parish Library during regular business hours or after Mass on the weekend. These library copies are in a binder located on the shelf near the window and are **not to be removed** from the library. You do have the choice to “opt out” of this program with a signed note. - ⇒ **PAYMENT POLICY**—Payment is expected at the time of registration. Fees will not exceed \$350 for any family registered in the parish before 6/30/10. It is our policy that children are entitled to attend regardless of their ability to pay. If you are experiencing financial difficulty, we do offer a payment plan. You must contact the Religious Education Office to discuss your options. **Please call before the Sep 1st deadline.** There is an additional \$150 family assessment fee for non-parishioners and new parishioners (new to the parish after 6/30/10). ❖
- ⇒ **WEATHER POLICY**—If the Troy School District (TSD) is closed due to weather conditions, Religious Education classes and programs are cancelled. **Check the website at www.stanastasia.org if unsure.** ❖

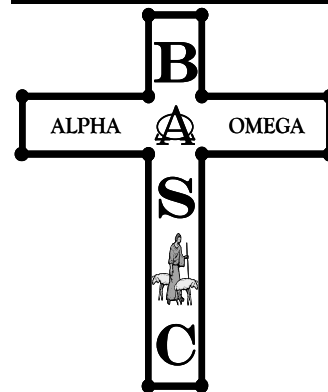
- ⇒ The date for the celebration of the **Rite of Confirmation** is not yet known.
