Please follow instructions carefully When ordering your engraved paver

- We welcome your personalized paver stone order throughout the year
- Actual placement of pavers takes on twice per year: once in the spring and once in the fall
 - The deadline for placing orders for a spring installation is May first.
 - The deadline for placing orders for a fall installation is October first.
- Your inscription for your paver stone must fit within the spaces on the appropriate grid on the reverse side
 - There is a separate grid for each size paver available for inscription
 - The prices for each size paver are listed above the appropriate grid
 - The 12x12 marker stones are engraved at no cost: they are included in the donation
 - These marker stones will be prominently in front of the bench, tree, or other specialty being donated
- Messages will be automatically centered on the paver by the engraver; you need not center the letters on the order grid
- NOTE: All blank spaces and punctuation count as spaces on the grid. Names are more readable if you place a space between the first and last name. If you run out of spaces, move the last name to the next line.
- Please print legibly
- All inscriptions are done in upper case

**Please double check your spelling and print carefully,
as any mistake is truly carved in stone and cannot be corrected.**
