Teens who are 17 or younger and working with children need to complete a **Called to Serve** workshop in order to volunteer.

Beaumont Communion Minister

Every Sunday, after the 8:00 AM Mass, ministers bring Holy Communion to Catholics at Troy Beaumont. You would not visit any COVID floors. You must be a "Beaumont Volunteer" to serve at the hospital and strict safety protocols are in place. A 4-step training process is provided. Communion to the Homebound

Once a week parishioners who are unable to participate in the Liturgy are visited and brought Holy Communion by rotating volunteers from the parish. The minister visits on the day of their choice, arranged in advance with the parishioners. The rotating schedule requires one half day of time every 4 to 5 weeks visiting 4 - 5 parishioners.
