ATTENTION EVERY VOLUNTEER!

Safe Environment Training We are ALL God's Children!

All adults who volunteer in our parish must receive Safe Environment training in a workshop called "Protecting God's Children" or "PGC".

This training is:

- To help protect vulnerable adults & children
- Mandatory for all volunteers serving anywhere in the AOD
- Free through a website called VIRTUS at www.virtus.org

If you have already attended a PGC workshop,

please keep reading: You will need Recertification Training! It also means you already have a VIRTUS account with a User ID and a Password for your account (even if you don't remember what those are). If you don't remember, go to www.virtus.org, click on the blue "I Need Login Help" box (under the login box) & follow the instructions. If you remember your login info, please login to www.virtus.org and follow the prompts. Need other help? Please email helpdesk@virtus.org or you may email Maryann at mbrani@stanastasia.org.

If you have never attended a PGC workshop in the past, you will need to create an account and complete training.

Safe Environment Training is so very important (and required) for our volunteers! We need you and your help and heart for others ... to take this mandatory training to help us keep all of our vulnerable adults and children in our community safe! Please go to www.virtus.org and create an account. Once you have created your account, save your login information and please follow the prompts. Need other help? All Teens (ages 14 – 17) who volunteer at St. Anastasia must create a Virtus account in the same way as adults using the guide above. Teens will be assigned the "Healthy Relationships" workshop – which is a 35 minute, online workshop.

Children 13 & under: Are with adults/chaperones and do not need to take Safe Environment Training at this time.

Beaumont Communion Minister

Every Sunday, after the 8:00 AM Mass, ministers bring Holy Communion to Catholics at Troy Beaumont. You would not visit any COVID floors. You must be a "Beaumont Volunteer" to serve at the hospital and strict safety protocols are in place. A 4-step training process is provided. You are able to schedule yourself every 4-6 weeks on a sign up genius. You are very much needed and are back home by lunchtime. Contact Kim Houseman at Ext. 112 or khouseman@stanastasia.org.

Communion to the Homebound

Once a week parishioners who are unable to participate in the Liturgy are visited and brought Holy Communion by rotating volunteers from the parish. The minister visits on the day of their choice, arranged in advance with the parishioners. The rotating schedule requires one half day of time every 4 to 5 weeks visiting 4 - 5 parishioners. Prepare the vessels and supplies for Holy Communion. Training is provided. Rotating schedule at the Weekend Mass of your choosing.
