# Safe Environment Training We are ALL God's Children!

All adults (18+) and teens (14 – 17 yrs) who volunteer in our parish must complete the Archdiocese of Detroit Safe Environment requirements as stated below:

#### Adults:

- 1) complete a Protecting God's Children (PGC) online training (a 2-hr self-paced video training) & sign the Code of Conduct
- 2) fill out and return a Background Check form (update every 2 years)

#### Teens:

1) complete a Healthy Relationships (online) training (a 35-minute video training)

#### If you have already attended a PGC workshop, please keep reading:

You will need Recertification Training every 3 years! It also means you already have a VIRTUS account with a User ID and Password (even if you don't remember what those are). If you don't remember your login information, go to www.virtusonline.org, click on the blue "I Need Login Help" link and follow the instructions. If you remember your login info, please login to www.virtusonline.org and follow the prompts. Need help? Please email helpdesk@virtus.org or email genoffice@stanastasia.org

If you have never attended a PGC workshop in the past, you (adults and teens) will need to create an account and complete training at www.virtusonline.org. Adults need to also fill out and return a Background Check form (available in the parish office and on our website). Need help? Please email either helpdesk@virtus.org or genoffice@stanastasia.org.

We need you and your help and heart for others ... to take this training to help us keep all of our vulnerable adults and children in our community safe!



Children 13 & under: Do not need to take this training.

Please pray about where God is calling you to serve your brothers and sisters in need. If you are already participating in a ministry, we ask you to pray and see if the Lord is calling you to go deeper, or to try something new.

Some of the ministries are just once a year, some require a full year, and some ministries fall somewhere in between. See the descriptions for details or ask the ministry coordinator.

If you are continuing on in an existing ministry, there is no need to fill out any form.

Forms are needed if you are serving in a new ministry only.

#### **Corewell Health Communion Minister**

Every Sunday, after the 8:00 AM Mass, ministers bring Holy Communion to Catholics at Troy Corewell. You must be a "Corewell Health / Beaumont Volunteer" to serve at the hospital and strict safety protocols are in place. A 4-step training process is provided. You are able to schedule yourself every 4-6 weeks on a sign up genius. You are very much needed and are back home by lunchtime. Email Christian Service at cservice@stanastasia.org.

#### Communion to the Homebound

Once a week, parishioners who are unable to participate in the Liturgy are visited and brought Holy Communion by rotating volunteers from the parish. The minister visits on the day of their choice, arranged in advance with the parishioners. The rotating schedule requires one half day of time every 4 to 5 weeks visiting 4 - 5 parishioners. # **Extraordinary Minister of the Holy Communion (EME)**

Being a Lector requires a desire to meditate on the Scripture and prepare in advance of each reading. Must be a registered, confirmed parishioner. Arrival time is 15 minutes prior to Mass. #### Sacristan (Daily Mass)

The role of the Sacristan is to arrive 30 minutes before Mass and prepare the altar for the Liturgy. They also are responsible for asking two people to bring up the offertory gifts. The Sacristans during the weekday liturgies usually lector for the Daily Mass, but it is not necessary. Training is provided. #### Sacristan (Fridays or Saturdays)

The Friday (or Saturday) Sacristan prepares and cleans the sanctuary & the sacristy for weekend Masses. The altar cloth is changed to the correct liturgical color. The Tabernacle is dusted. Holy water fonts are cleaned and fresh Holy Water is added into the fonts. Training is provided along with a rotating schedule. No prior experience is required.
